Challenge: Realign the library with the geometry of the historic campus building, thereby strengthening the building's relationship to the rest of the campus.

- three-level, 36,000-square-foot addition and 63,000-square-foot renovation
- lecture hall, academic computing center, art display space, interactive video system facility, library instruction room, language lab, and mechanical and electrical rooms
- reference/circulation desk, copy center, reference/administrative offices, reference stacks and services, inter-library loan, and audio/visual media services
- various seating groups within and surrounding stacks with views to the campus, International Bridge, and Canadian highlands
- conversion of circle drive to pedestrian traffic only
